SAFETY CHECKLIST: FIRE AND ELECTRIC SHOCK HAZARD

- 1. Unit must be electrically grounded.
- 2. Insert 3-prong plug on power cord directly into matching grounded
- receptacle.
- 3. Do not use with an adapter.
- 4. Do not use with an extension cord.
- 5. Inspect power cord before use. Never operate with damaged power cord.



WARNING

- Keep wiring and motor dry.
- 2. Do not operate in standing water.
- If electrical components become wet, allow them to dry completely before using.

Tool Application: The 3-speed Carpet Blower accelerates the evaporation of moisture from materials. Position flat to dry floors, or tip back to dry a wall. Position on its back to blow air up to dry ceilings.



Tool Operation:

Step	Action
1	Unwrap the cord wrap completely.
2	Place the Carpet Blower with the outlet directed at damp area.
3	Plug the unit into a standard 115V grounded outlet. Each Carpet Blower needs 5 amps to operate on high (3 amps on low; 3.5 amps on medium).
4	To switch the unit on, rotate the switch to the speed desired.
5	The Carpet Blower can be operated flat or at 5° (with kickstand), 45° and 90°.
6	For maximum performance, make sure nothing is blocking or restricting the side inlet grill.
7	When finished, turn switch off, unplug unit, and completely wrap cord around back cord wrap.
