

One Earth Floor Cleaner

Cleaner for hard surface floors

BACKGROUND

Floors are the most soiled part of any building so they require frequent cleaning. Because they are cleaned so often, the floor care products must be designed carefully. They must have good soil removal, require no rinsing, have good tolerance to hard water and leave no residue that will cause streaking or stickiness. Floors that have acrylic finishes also require products that will not damage the finish or reduce gloss. These cleaning solutions should also have low foam so that rinsing is easier.

One Earth Floor Cleaner meets all these requirements.

One Earth Floor Cleaner can be used for general surface cleaning as well as routine damp mopping of water cleanable hard surface floors.

ITEMS NEEDED

- One Earth Floor Cleaner
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) as specified in the Safety Data Sheet (SDS)
- **Supplies:** wet floor signs, adequate supply of clean cloths and a plastic bag for the storage of soiled mops, measuring cup, wet mop or microfiber mop / bucket / wringer.

PREQUALIFICATION: Check compatibility of product with the surfaces prior to use.

PROCEDURE FOR NO RINSE FLOOR CLEANING

- 1. Post wet floor signs.
- 2. Remove loose soil using vacuum, dust mop or sweeping.
- 3. Prepare a ready to use (RTU) solution by diluting ½ ounce of concentrate to enough cold water to make 1 gallon (4 mL/L).
- 4. Begin mopping using a wet mop or microfiber floor pad. Be sure that the mop or floor pad is clean. Use a continuous mopping action so that soil collects on the leading edge of the mop or pad.
- 5. Change the solution as it becomes soiled.
- 6. Be sure to establish good drying conditions.
- 7. Inspect floor for cleanliness.

PROCEDURE FOR GENERAL CLEANING

- 1. Remove loose soil using vacuum, dust mop or sweeping.
- 2. Prepare a ready to use (RTU) solution by diluting 4 ounces of concentrate to enough cold water to make 1 gallon (30 mL/L).
- 3. Apply to surface and allow a short dwell time and damp wipe or rinse. Agitate stubborn soils then rinse.
- 4. Be sure to establish good drying conditions.
- 5. Inspect surface for cleanliness.

CLEAN UP

- Check all PPE for damage. Repair or replace as needed.
- Rinse equipment to remove product residues and waste water. Be sure to dispose waste water and unused
 product properly according to local, state, Federal or provincial regulations. Never dispose into surface waters or
 into a storm drain.

Offer empty and rinsed container for recycling, where facilities exist.

SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

- · Wash hands after using the product.
- · Keep children and pets away from your work area, from chemical products and from your equipment.
- Read the Safety Data Sheets (SDSs) for all products before using them. You can obtain the SDSs from your distributor or from www.LegendBrandsCleaning.com
- Use the personal protective equipment specified in the SDS. Rubber Gloves, Safety Glasses and body-covering clothing should be worn.
- Follow label directions. Improper use can cause injury or damage to surfaces.

Note: Avoid contact with surfaces that can be damaged by water such as bare wood floors.
