A two-part stain removal system for artificial dye stains on synthetic carpet and upholstery

APPLICATION: Spotter

DESCRIPTION

Red Rescue is formulated exclusively to remove red food coloring spots from carpet. Removes food coloring spots from children's drinks, carbonated beverages, wine and other sources. For the toughest synthetic dye stains on synthetic carpet and upholstery fibers, the potent ingredients in 2-part Red Rescue can do the job. It chemically alters colored foods, sauces and beverages, cough medicine, mouthwash and other synthetic dyes. Most dye spots disappear within minutes of heat activation.

FEATURES

- Especially formulated to remove food coloring spots from carpet
- · Removes red drink spots, wine stains, berry spots and other food dyes
- Meets specifications for use on stain-resistant carpet
- Two-part system for more powerful spot removal action

WHERE TO USE

Use to remove red food coloring and other food coloring spots from synthetic carpet and upholstery fibers.

USE DILUTION:

Mix equal amounts of Part A and Part B

USE DIRECTIONS:

Pre-test: USE IN A WELL-VENTILATED AREA. Pre-test the product and procedure in an inconspicuous area for colorfastness or any undesirable effects.

Mixing: Mix equal amounts of Part A and Part B.

Spotting: Sponge or scrape up any surface spot material.

- 1. Mix equal parts of Red Rescue Part A and Part B. Apply mixture directly to the spot. Do not apply to non-stained carpet.
- 2. Red Rescue removes many dye stains without heat. Allow 5-10 minutes dwell time. If spot is removed skip step 3, proceed to extraction in step 4.
- 3. If spot still remains, dampen a clean white terry cloth towel with water and lay it on the spot. Set a steam iron or steamer for high heat (cotton/linen setting), place iron on the towel over the spot for 30—60 seconds. DO NOT allow iron to directly contact carpet. Check for spot removal. Repeat as necessary.
- 4. Extract area with clear water. Brush to align fibers. Discard any unused mixture.

USAGE TIPS:

USE IN A WELL-VENTILATED AREA. May cause allergic reaction in some asthmatics and sulfite-sensitive individuals.

NOTE: Red Rescue can cause color loss (bleaching) in some delicate fabrics. Always pretest in an inconspicuous location, for possible dye loss or other undesirable effects on some types of carpet or fabric.

- Fresh dye spots are removed more easily than aged spots.
- To avoid pile and texture changes, blot do not rub.
- Stain removal results depend on age of spot, size, dye strength, as well as characteristics of the carpet fiber and dyes.
- Not recommended for natural fabrics such as cotton or wool because of risk of color loss.
- For natural dye stains such as fruit juice, berry stains, wine, coffee, tea, grass stains try Stain Rescue.
